### IN-HOUSE PATIENTS FUNDED

Only those patients are selected for funding who pass a stringent system of eligibility and financial assessment by PBS's steering committee. The system of approval is three layered, getting recommended first by the concerned doctor at duty, followed by PBS's scrutiny committee and finally PBS's finance secretary. We are very particular that your charity reaches the most deserving patients.

Some of the salient cases that PBS was involved in thus far are as follows:

- 72 yr old Jannat bibi, admitted in Nephiro ward (MR #: 16006612) who needed urgent dialysis- Provided with LV drugs and dialysis material free of cost by PBS.
- 20 yr old Sidra bibi (MR #: 16006260), who underwent tonsillectomy-All expenses borne by PBS.
- 40 yr old Mr. Munawwar (MR#: 16031342) underwent successful CABG for IHD (Double Vessel Disease) -Total expenditure- Rs 250,000-Sponsored by PBS (Testimony of patient on PBS's page)
- 17 yr old Rukhsana Bibi from KPK (referred to PBS by Al-Khidmat Foundation) suffered from congenital choledochal cyst -PBS facilitated this patient and managed to get hepaticojejunostomy done after excision of choledochal cyst by Liver Transplant Dep. (Testimony of father on PBS's page)
- Sultan Ahmed, suffering from Horse shoe Kidney disease-Expenses on surgery and medication borne by PBS, after which patient is well.
- 60 yr old Yasmeen Bibi diagnosis with the rare Factor XI deficiency (Haemophilia C). Total cost of treatment - Rs. 294,000, out of which Rs. 160,000 donated by PBS. Patient is well now Alhamdulillah.

Total number of indoor patients funded so far : approx. 60

### 1<sup>st</sup> EVER EARTHQUAKE MEDICAL AND RELIEF CAMP (31-10-2015 to 02-11-2015)

PBS successfully organized a 1<sup>st</sup> ever earthquake and medical relief camp in the earthquake hit areas of KPK (Lower Deer, Upper Deer, Shangla, Chitral) from 31<sup>st</sup> Oct 15 to 2<sup>nd</sup> Nov 2015 in which more than 3000 patients were provided free medicines and checkup.
